## CHIANTI COLLI SENESI

Denominazione di Origine Controllata e Garantita



Chianti Colli Senesi is made from Sangiovese grapes grown in the Montepulciano and surrounding communes of Siena. Its color is ruby red with violet hues. The bouquet is full and lingering with pleasing notes of fruit and brushwood. Its flavors

are dry and lasting, with pleasing hints of red berry and mineral that express the balance between tannins and acidity. This wine pairs well with grilled and roasted meats. Serve this wine at a temperature of  $16^{\circ}$ - $18^{\circ}$  C ( $60^{\circ}$ - $65^{\circ}$  F).
